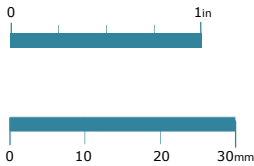


HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

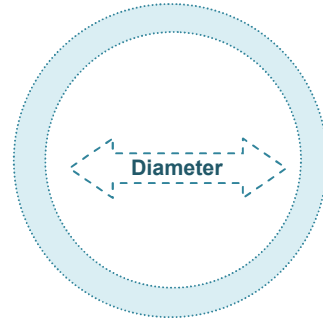
CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE



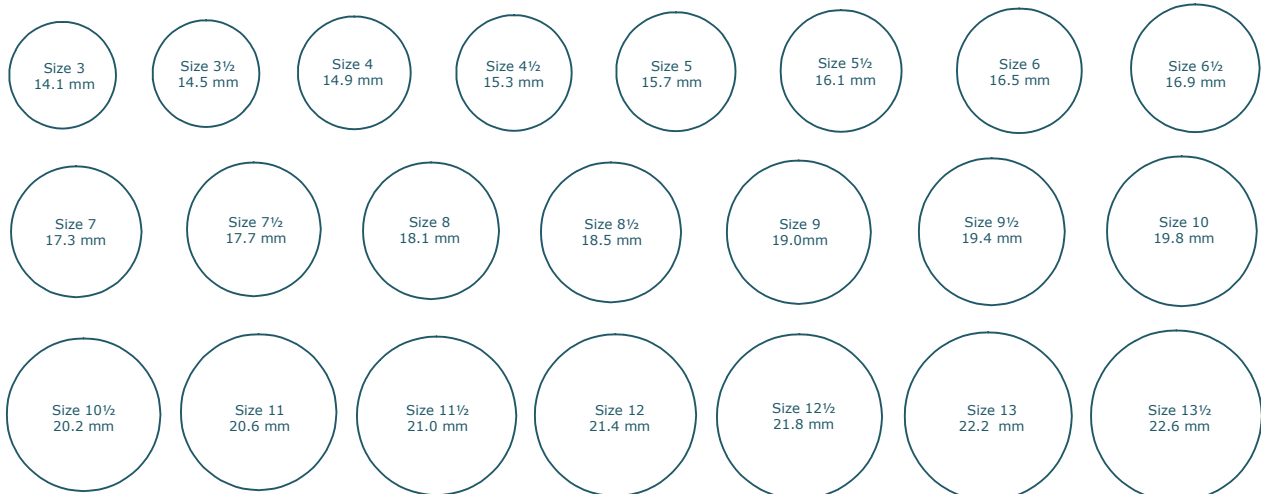
1. **Ring measurements are exact.** Carefully follow these instructions to ensure accurate measurement
2. **Before printing,** ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print settings. (To check settings, press CTRL+P)
3. **After printing, confirm correct scale by measuring the bar on the left.** It must be exactly 1 inch long. You can also place a quarter over the image to see if it fits exactly in the box. If either test fails, the chart below will not be accurate.

Measure Current Ring

1. Select a ring that currently fits the intended finger. Wedding and Engagement rings are traditionally worn on the ring finger on the left hand.
2. Place the ring over the circles below and find the circle which matches the inside edge of the ring. The measurement in mm shows the diameter of the ring.
3. If the ring falls in between 2 sizes, we recommend you order the larger size. If a quarter size is necessary, we can custom make most rings in quarter sizes through a customer service rep.
